The Educational Program

Since Windsor Mountain is a college preparatory school, major attention is focused on satisfying the entrance requirements of leading colleges and universities. At the same time, however, the curriculum includes a variety of electives so that students may broaden their base of knowledge. The program is based on a combination of the best European and American educational methods, gained from twenty years' experience in educational administration.

Minimum requirements for graduation are four years of English, two years of science, two years of history, two years of mathematics, three years of one foreign language or two years of two languages, and one year of music or art. Every effort is made to meet specific requirements of the college which the student wishes to enter.

Classes are forty minutes long and are held five days a week. Each student takes five classes daily. Classes are small so there is ample opportunity for individual attention, and students are encouraged to question and discuss. Field trips, aptitude tests, and consistent guidance supplement regular classroom work.
